 - parasternal short axis
 - parasternal long axis
 - apical four chamber
 - subcostal four chamber
- 3) understand scanning techniques and interpretation techniques for lung US exam

Regional Ultrasound Workshop *

- 1) describe the equipment and basic procedural steps required for placement of US-guided suprainguinal fascia iliaca, erector spinae plane, serratus anterior plane, and paravertebral blocks
